Note: In case the vendor failed to comply with the above provisions, TDS shall be deducted at the higher of the following rates, namely: -

- (i) at twice the rate specified in the relevant provision of the Act; or
- (ii) at twice the rate or rates in force; or
- (iii) at the rate of five per cent (5%).
