3.	It is fully understood that this guarantee is effective from the date of the said contract and that we (name of the bank), undertake not to revoke this guarantee during its currency, without the consent in writing of the Purchaser.
4.	We undertake to pay to the Purchaser, any money so demanded, notwithstanding any dispute or disputes raised by the Contractor, in any suit or proceeding pending before any Court or Tribunal, relating thereto, our liability under this present, being absolute and unequivocal. The payments so made by us under this bond, shall be a valid discharge of our liability for payment thereunder, and the Contractor shall have no claim against us, for making such payments.
