Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. 1. Required Terms of Delivery: F.O.R. Security Paper Mill Narmadapuram (Duly Unloaded).

2. Destination: Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (M.P.)-461005

3. Payment Terms: 100% payment on receipt and acceptance (suitability) of goods by the SPM, Narmadap uram and on production of all required documents by the supplier and providing training (to minimum 5 p ersons) and successful installation and commissioning of the item at SPM, Narmadapuram.

4. Bidder Should Quote Prices Inclusive of GST And All Cost Components Such As Packing & Forwarding Det ails, Freight & Insurance Charges upto Destination etc. on FOR Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (Madhy a Pradesh), India basis only.

5. Liquidated Damages (LD) Clause: If the contractor fails to deliver the goods and/or services or any instal lment thereof within the Delivery Period, SPM Narmadapuram shall, without prejudice to other rights and r emedies available to SPM, Narmadapuram under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as Liquidate d damages, a sum equivalent to the rate of 0.5 Percent of the delivered price of the delayed goods and/or services for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% of the delayed goods or services.

6. The terms and conditions, guidelines of SPMCIL Procurement Manual Version 3.0 will be applicable to thi s bid at any stage to avoid any conflict at later stage. 8. Vendor has to submit declaration in specified format (refer Buyer added Specific ATC) for the complianc e of Section 206AB of Income Tax Act, 1961. In case of non-submission of declaration; TDS will be deducte d at higher rates (as applicable) as per section 206AB.

9. GST Return: Supplier should file the GST returns for outward supplies in time. SPM reserves the right to withhold the payment of further supplies till production of evidence of filling of Returns.

10. Bidder shall submit duly seal & signed copy of Technical Specifications.

11. Delivery Period: 120 days for complete supply, installation, commissioning and training with Final Acce ptance Testing (FAT) from the date of issue of GeM order.

3. Warranty

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 1 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

4. Generic

Installation, Commissioning, Testing, Configuration, Training (if any - which ever is applicable as per scope of supply) is to be carried out by OEM / OEM Certified resource or OEM authorised Reseller.

5. Generic

Manufacturer Authorization:Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid
