- 1.  - ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.

Details of Scope of Work:-

- 1. Chilled Iron Roll is fitted with bearing block including bearing & Econip Roll is fitted with Plane bearing in cluding both side DPR (Differential Pressure Regulator); Vendor should take care of the bearing, bearing ho usings & DPR during job execution.
- 2. Grinding of Calendar Chilled Iron Roll as per technical specifications of the rolls.
- 3. Grinding of Calendar Eco Nip Soft Roll as per technical specifications of the rolls.
- 4. Rolls have to be necessarily grinded with CNC roll grinding machine with high accuracy.
- 5. Calender Chilled Iron Roll have to be grinded within the grinding tolerances mentioned in the specifications.

Vendor has to submit roll dimensional reports for pre-grinding and post-grinding of Chilled Iron roll.

- 6. Eco Soft Nip Roll has to be grinded within the grinding tolerances mentioned in the specifications.
- 7. Vendor has to ensure that grinding wheels of their machine should not touch the roll surface of Soft Nip Roll, where internal longitudinal strips exist. Vendor has to take all necessary care that internals of the roll do not get damage while grinding.
- 8. Vendor has to apply removable type rust preventive paint on Chilled Iron Roll surface immediately after the grinding job is completed.
- 9. Before grinding it is essential to measure grinding curve of rolls.
- a) Initial reading (before Grinding).
- b) Final reading (after Grinding).
- c) Surface Roughness (before grinding) Ra (in microns).
- d) Surface Roughness (after grinding) Ra (in microns).
- 13. Both Rolls should be static balance and firm should provide the BALANCING certificate for the same.
- 10. To and fro transportation of the rolls will be in SPM scope.

- 11. Unloading and loading of rolls at Vendor's premises shall be their responsibility. Vendor has to ensure that packing boxes of the rolls are kept safe and rolls are properly packed in the same boxes after grinding.
- 12. SPM shall depute their representative for pre-dispatch inspection. SPM may have right to wave-off PDI.

6. Warranty (as per clause no. 16 of GCC)

- 6.1. The supplier warrants that the goods supplied under the contract is new, unused, and incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials unless prescribed otherwise by S PMN in the contract. The supplier further warrants that the goods supplied under the contract s hall have no defect arising from design, materials (except when the design adopted and / or the material used are as per SPMN's specifications) or workmanship or from any act or omission of the supplier, that may develop under normal use of the supplied goods under the conditions prevailing in India.
- 6.2. This warranty shall remain valid for twelve months after the goods or any portion thereof as the case may be, have been delivered to the final destination and installed and commissioned at the final destination and accepted by SPMCIL in terms of the contract or for fifteen months from the date of despatch from the supplier's premises for domestic goods (including goods already imported by the supplier under its own arrangement) or for eighteen months after the date of shipment from the port of loading in the source country for imported goods offered from abroad, whichever is earlier, unless specified otherwise in the SCC.
- 7. **Anti-Bribery Management System (ABMS):** By participating in this tender, the suppliers/V endors/ Contractors are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take, any finan cial or non-financial bribe, to or from anyone during the tender or during the execution of the c ontract thereafter and if they notice any such incident happening, they shall report it to Vigilan ce.
- 8. The terms and conditions, guidelines of SPMCIL Procurement Manual Version 3.0 will be applic able to this bid at any stage to avoid any conflict at later stage.
