- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of guality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
- 2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity  $\div$  Original quantity)  $\times$  Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

#### 2. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

### 3. Generic

While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.

### 4. Scope of Supply

### 1. Required Terms of Delivery:

- i. Required Terms of Delivery: F.O.R. Security Paper Mill Narmadapuram duly unloaded.
- ii. Destination: Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (M.P.)-461005
- 2. **Delivery Schedule:** The contract shall remain valid up to one year from the issue of GeM Contract/ NAC wh ichever is earlier and Material shall be taken in staggered manner.
  - (i) 300 Kg. within 30 days from date of issue of GeM contract/ NAC whichever is earlier.
  - (ii) For Remaining quantities, SPM shall intimate the date/period of delivery/ies minimum 3 0 days in advance through E-mail/letter.

#### Note:-

- a) The allowable periodic variation would be +/- 5%. Under no circumstances, materials will be accepted bey ond (+)5% allowed quantity tolerance. Any variation in periodic rate of supply more than (-)5% in each del ivery schedule would be considered as delay in delivery. LD will be imposed on such short supplies beyon d (-)5% for each delivery. This is without prejudice to Force Majeure Clause. In any circumstances, the tota I Purchase Order qty. will not be exceeded.
- **b)** The above delivery schedule may be vary as per our requirement.
- 3. **Payment Terms:** 100% on receipt and acceptance (suitability) of goods by the SPM, Narmadapuram and on production of all required documents by the supplier.
- 4. Bidder should quote prices inclusive of GST and all cost components such as packing & forwarding details, fr eight & insurance charges upto destination etc. on FOR Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (Madhya Pradesh), India.
- 5. **Liquidated Damages (LD) Clause:** If the contractor fails to deliver the goods and/or services or any install ment thereof within the Delivery Period, SPM Narmadapuram shall, without prejudice to other rights and reme dies available to SPM, Narmadapuram under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as Liquidated dama

ges, a sum equivalent to the rate of 0.5 Percent of the delivered price of the delayed goods and/or services fo r each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% of the delayed goods or services.

- 7. SPM (as Buyer) is liable to deduct TDS u/s 194Q @ applicable rate on goods purchases (if applicable). In case of deduction of TDS under section 194Q; the Supplier (Vendor) need not to charge TCS u/s 206C (1H) on invoicing on or after 01.07.2021.
- Vendor has to submit declaration in specified format for the compliance of Section 206AB of Income Tax Act, 1961. In case of non-submission of declaration; TDS will be deducted at higher rates (as applicable) as per section 206AB.
- GST Return: Supplier should file the GST returns for outward supplies in time. SPM reserves the right to withh old the payment of further supplies till production of evidence of filling of Returns.

#### 10. WARRANTY CLAUSE:

- (i) The warranty shall remain valid for Twelve months after the goods have been delivered to the final destination and accepted by SPM in terms of the contract or for fifteen months from the date of dispat ch from the supplier's premises for domestic goods whichever is earlier.
- (ii) In case of any claim arising out of this warranty, SPMCIL shall promptly notify the same in writing to the supplier.
- (iii) Upon receipt of such notice, the supplier shall, with all reasonable speed replace the defective good s or parts thereof, free of cost, at the ultimate destination. The supplier shall take over the replaced p arts/ goods after providing their replacements and no claim, whatsoever shall lie on SPM for such replaced parts/ goods thereafter.
- (iv) In the event of any rectification of a defect or replacement of any defective goods during the warran ty period, the warranty for the rectified/ replaced goods shall be extended to a further period of twelv e months from the date such rectified / replaced goods starts functioning to the satisfaction of SPM.
- (v) If the supplier, having been notified, fails to rectify/replace the defect(s) within a reasonable period SPM may proceed to take such remedial action(s) as deemed fit by SPM, at the risk and expense of the supplier and without prejudice to other contractual rights and remedies, which SPM may have again st the supplier.

- iii. Material shall be tested in SPM QC lab & decision of SPM QC lab shall be final & binding on the contract.
- iv. Certificate of chemical analysis (COA) must accompany with each supply. Along with all the technical spe cification as given in NIT,
- v. The material must be free from any kind of contamination like dirt, foreign particle, sand, etc., non-adher ence of the same may lead the rejection of material.
- vi. The packing shall bear legibly the following information:
  - a) Name & Grade of the material;
  - b) Name of the manufacturer and his recognized trade-mark, if any;
  - c) Weight in Kg.
  - d) Month & Year of packing;
  - e) Batch number
  - f) Shelf life/Best before.

# 14. OPTION CLAUSE:

The Purchaser reserves the right to increase/decrease the ordered quantity by up to 25% at any time, till fi nal delivery date of the contract (or the extended delivery date of the contract), by giving reasonable notic e even though the quantity ordered initially has been supplied in full before the last date of Delivery Period (or the extended delivery period of the contract.

### 15. SHORT CLOSE/ TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:

The Chief General Manager, Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram, reserve the right at any stage by giving due notice without assigning any reason:-

- (i) To short close or terminate the order at any time during process of supply against our supply order.
- (ii) To reduce the tender quantity at the time of concluding the final supply order.

### 16. Resolution of Disputes:

If dispute or difference of any kind shall arise between SPM, Narmadapuram and the supplier in connection wi th or relating the contract, the parties shall make every effort to resolve the same amicably by mutual consult ations. If the parties fail to resolve their dispute or difference by such mutual consultation within 21 days of it s occurrence, then, unless otherwise provided in the SCC, either SPM, Narmadapuram or the supplier may seek recourse to settlement of disputes through arbitration act 33.2.

17. In case a tenderer attempts to influence SPMCIL's decision on scrutiny, comparison, evaluation, and award of the contracts, it will be treated as a serious misdemeanour. In such a case the tender of the tenderer shall be liable for rejection in addition to appropriate administrative actions being taken against that tenderer, as dee med fit by SPMCIL, in terms of clause 44 of GIT.

- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.

- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
