### **ADDITIONAL TERMS & CONDITIONS (ATC)**

- 1. Required Terms of Delivery:** F.O.R. Security Paper Mill Narmadapuram .
- 2. Destination:** Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (M.P.)-461005.
- 3.** Bidder Should Quote Prices Inclusive of GST And All Cost Components Such As Packing & Forwarding Details, Freight & Insurance Charges up to Destination etc. on FOR Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (Madhya Pradesh), India basis only.
- 4. Liquidated Damages (LD) Clause:** If the contractor fails to deliver the goods and/or services or any instalment thereof within the Delivery Period, SPM Narmadapuram shall, without prejudice to other rights and remedies available to SPM, Narmadapuram under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as Liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to the rate of 0.5 per cent of the delivered price of the delayed goods and/or services for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% of the delayed goods or services.
- 5.** The terms and conditions, guidelines of SPMCIL Procurement Manual Version 3.0 will be applicable to this bid at any stage to avoid any conflict at later stage. - 6.** SPM (as Buyer) is liable to deduct TDS u/s 194Q @ applicable rate on goods purchases (if applicable) . In case of deduction of TDS under section 194Q; the Supplier (Vendor) need not to charge TCS u/s 206C (1H) on invoicing on or after 01.07.2021.
- 7.** Vendor has to submit declaration in specified format (refer Buyer added Specific ATC) for the compliance of Section 206AB of Income Tax Act, 1961. In case of non-submission of declaration; TDS will be deducted at higher rates (as applicable) as per section 206AB. - **Not Applicable**
- 8. GST Return:** Supplier should file the GST returns for outward supplies in time. In case of any Input Credit Loss to SPM by way of their failure to files GST Returns in time, SPM reserves the right to withhold the payment of further supplies till production of evidence of filling of Returns.
- 9. Delivery Period:** as per attached Scope of Work
- 10.** Bidder shall submit duly seal & signed copy of Scope of Work/Technical Specifications and declaration.

- 11. Payment terms:** As per attached Milestones of Payment and Scope of Work
- 12. Warranty/Continued Service:** To provide technical support as and when required from the date of placement of supply/work order till the completion of contract period. Consultant will continue to extend their full support to SPM for 12 months from the date of final acceptance (FAC) for the successful implementation of the project.
- 13. Anti-Bribery Management System (ABMS):** By participating in this tender, the suppliers/Vendors / Contractors are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take, any financial or non-financial bribe, to or from anyone during the tender or during the execution of the contract thereafter and if they notice any such incident happening, they shall report it to Vigilance.
- 14. Resolution of Disputes in case of Arbitration** at India International Arbitration Centre, New Delhi
- 15. Common IP Addresses:** Bidders may please note that GeM is capturing and showing the IP addresses used by the Buyer and the Bidder(s)/Seller(s). The received bids having matching/common IP address with either Bidder(s)/Seller(s) or Buyer, shall be outrightly rejected & shall not be considered for further evaluation.
- 16.** In case a tenderer attempts to influence SPMCIL's decision on scrutiny, comparison, evaluation, and award of the contracts, it will be treated as a serious misdemeanour. In such a case the tender of the tenderer shall be liable for rejection in addition to appropriate administrative actions being taken against that tenderer, as deemed fit by SPMCIL, in terms of clause 44 of GIT.
- 17. Pre-Bid conference**
1. Prospective bidders interested in participating in this tender may attend a pre-bid conference for clarification on technical specifications and commercial conditions of the Tenders, at SPM, Narmadapuram as mentioned.
  2. Participation is not mandatory, however, in case a bidder chooses not to participate (or fails to do so) in the pre-bid conference, it would be assumed that they have no issues regarding the Technical/ commercial specifications/ conditions.
  3. Prospective bidders may submit their queries in writing before 7 days of the Pre Bid Conference.
  4. Delegates coming for the pre-bid conference must bring with them a photo identity and also an authorization letter as per format in Section XVII: "Letter of Authority for attending a Pre-Bid Conference/ Bid Opening" from their Company/ principals, else they would not be allowed to participate.
  5. After the pre-bid conference a clarification letter would be issued, containing amendments if required, of various provisions of the Bid-Documents, which shall form part of the Bid document.

If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
