4. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder

Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.

5. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity ÷ Original quantity) × Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original

delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. **Certificates**

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

1. **Required Terms of Delivery:**

1. Required Terms of Delivery: F.O.R. Security Paper Mill Narmadapuram duly unloaded.
2. Destination: Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (M.P.)-461005

2. **Payment Terms:** 100% on receipt and acceptance (suitability) of goods by the SPM, Narmadapuram and on production of all required documents by the supplier.

3. Bidder should quote prices inclusive of GST and all cost components such as packing & forwarding de tails, freight & insurance charges upto destination etc. on FOR Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (Ma dhya Pradesh), India.

4. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

(a) **For MSE/Start-up firm:** Capability - Equipment & Manufacturing Facilities: The bidder firm sh ould have capability to manufacture and supply of tendered item.

(b) **For other firm - Experience and past performance:** The bidder firm may be Manufacturer/ Proven supplier/Authorized dealer or distributor of tendered item or bidder may participate with manuf acturing authorization form (issued by manufacturer of tendered item).

Note: Participating bidder needs to submit all related documents along with the bid.

5. If required, SPM may visit the factory during techno-commercial bid stage, to ascertain the bidder ma nufacturing capability & quality control methodology.

6. **Liquidated Damages (LD) Clause:** If the contractor fails to deliver the goods and/or services or an y installment thereof within the Delivery Period, SPM Narmadapuram shall, without prejudice to other r ights and remedies available to SPM, Narmadapuram under the contract, deduct from the contract pric e, as Liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to the rate of 0.5 Percent of the delivered price of the dela yed goods and/or services for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% of the delayed goods or services.

7. The terms and conditions, guidelines of SPMCIL Procurement Manual Version 3.0 will be applicable to this bid at any stage to avoid any conflict at later stage. 8. SPM (as Buyer) is liable to deduct TDS u/s 194Q @ applicable rate on goods purchases (if applicable).

In case of deduction of TDS under section 194Q; the Supplier (Vendor) need not to charge TCS u/s 206C (1H) on invoicing on or after 01.07.2021.

9. GST Return: Supplier should file the GST returns for outward supplies in time. SPM reserves the right to withhold the payment of further supplies till production of evidence of filing of Returns.

10. **Delivery Schedule: The contract remain valid up to 150 days from the issue of GeM Contract and delivery schedule as per below:**

- (i) 500 Kg. within 30 days from issue of GeM Contract.
- (ii) 475 Kg. within 120 days after the first supply.

11. **WARRANTY CLAUSE:**

(a) The warranty shall remain valid for Twelve months after the goods have been delivered to the final destination and accepted by SPM in terms of the contract or for fifteen months from the date of dispatch from the supplier's premises for domestic goods whichever is earlier.

(b) In case of any claim arising out of this warranty, SPMCIL shall promptly notify the same in writing to the supplier.

(c) Upon receipt of such notice, the supplier shall, with all reasonable speed replace the defective goods or parts thereof, free of cost, at the ultimate destination. The supplier shall take over the replaced parts/ goods after providing their replacements and no claim, whatsoever shall lie on SPM for such replaced parts/ goods thereafter.

(d) In the event of any rectification of a defect or replacement of any defective goods during the warranty period, the warranty for the rectified/ replaced goods shall be extended to a further period of twelve months from the date such rectified / replaced goods starts functioning to the satisfaction of SPM.

(e) If the supplier, having been notified, fails to rectify/replace the defect(s) within a reasonable period SPM may proceed to take such remedial action(s) as deemed fit by SPM, at the risk and expense of the supplier and without prejudice to other contractual rights and remedies, which SPM may have against the supplier.

12. **OPTION CLAUSE:**

The Purchaser reserves the right to increase/decrease the ordered quantity by up to 25% at any time, till final delivery date of the contract (or the extended delivery date of the contract), by giving reasonable notice even though the quantity ordered initially has been supplied in full before the last date of Delivery Period (or the extended delivery period of the contract).

13. **SHORT CLOSE/ TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:**

The Chief General Manager, Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram, reserve the right at any stage by giving due notice without assigning any reason:-

- (i) To short close or terminate the order at any time during process of supply against our supply order.
- (ii) To reduce the tender quantity at the time of concluding the final supply order.

14. **Resolution of Disputes:**

If dispute or difference of any kind shall arise between SPM, Narmadapuram and the supplier in connection with or relating the contract, the parties shall make every effort to resolve the same amicably by mutual consultations. If the parties fail to resolve their dispute or difference by such mutual consultation within 21 days of its occurrence, then, unless otherwise provided in the SCC, either SPM, Narma

dapuram or the supplier may seek recourse to settlement of disputes through arbitration act 33.2.
Note:- Any dispute relating to the enquiry shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the court at Narmadapuram only.

15. Quality Control Requirements:

After receipt of the material, the same shall be inspected in compliance with the technical specifications. If the material supplied fails to adhere the technical specification, then the same shall be rejected at the risk & cost of the supplier.

16. Contacting SPMCIL:

(i) From the time of submission of tender to the time of awarding the contract, if a tenderer needs to contact SPMCIL for any reason relating to this tender enquiry and / or its tender, it should do so only in writing.

(ii) It will be treated as a serious misdemeanour in case a tenderer attempts to influence SPMCIL's decision on scrutiny, comparison, evaluation, and award of the contracts. In such a case the tender of the tenderer shall be liable for rejection in addition to appropriate administrative actions being taken against that tenderer, as deemed fit by SPMCIL, in terms of clause 44 of GIT.

17. Anti-Bribery Management System (ABMS): By participating in this tender, the suppliers/Vendors / Contractors are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take, any financial or non-financial bribe, to or from anyone during the tender or during the execution of the contract thereafter and if they notice any such incident happening, they shall report it to Vigilance.

Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-
